

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(BARTLE LANE, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY) (SPEED HUMPS)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in accordance with Section 90A of the **Highways Act 1980**, Lancashire County Council propose to introduce speed humps in the following locations:

- a) Bartle Lane, Preston, from a point 40 metres west of its junction with the centreline of Mossy Close for a distance of 3 metres in an easterly direction;
- b) Bartle Lane, Preston, from a point 27 metres east of its junction with the centreline of Mossy Close for a distance of 3 metres in an easterly direction;
- c) Bartle Lane, Preston, from a point 97 metres east of its junction with the centreline of Mossy Close for a distance of 3 metres in an easterly direction;
- d) Bartle Lane, Preston, from a point 162 metres east of its junction with the centreline of Mossy Close for a distance of 3 metres in a north easterly direction.
