

NOTICE OF MAKING
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
**(NEW QUAY ROAD, LANCASTER, LANCASTER CITY) (PROHIBITION OF ENTRY AND
PROHIBITION OF ENTRY EXCEPT BUSES) ORDER 202***

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 13th August 2026 Lancashire County Council made the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to:

1. Introduce a prohibition of entry in New Quay Road, Lancaster, entry into the bus turning circle to be prohibited at its southernmost junction with New Quay Road.
2. Introduce a prohibition of entry except buses in New Quay Road, Lancaster, entry into the bus turning circle to be prohibited at its northernmost junction with New Quay Road.

This Order will come into force on the 31st August 2026. A copy of the Order, and all other relevant documents may be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of Lancaster City Council, Town Hall, Dalton Square, Lancaster, LA1 1PJ, and at the offices of The Director of Law and Governance, Lancashire County Council, County Hall, PO Box 100, Preston PR1 0LD, and on Lancashire County Councils Website <https://www.lancashire.gov.uk/roads-parking-and-travel/roads/roadworks-and-traffic-regulation-orders/permanent-traffic-regulation-orders/>, **quoting ref: LSG4/894_19588/AFR**. Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
