

NOTICE OF MAKING
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(VARIOUS LOCATIONS, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (REVOCATION OF RESTRICTED
ROADS) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 13th August 2026 Lancashire County Council made the above Speed Limit Order under Sections 82(2) and 83(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to revoke the following:

- a) "The Lancashire County Council (Restricted Roads) (No.2) Order 1981" in full;
- b) "The Lancashire County Council (Course Lane A5209. Newburgh, West Lancashire District) (Restricted Road) Order 1994" in full;
- c) "The Lancashire County Council (Higher Lane C161, Dalton, West Lancashire District) (Restricted Road) Order 1994" in full;
- d) The "Lancashire County Council (Various Road Including A570 and A577, Burscough, Blaguegate, Ormskirk, Skelmersdale and Westhead, West Lancashire) (Revocation, Restricted Road, De-Restriction, 40mph and 50mph Speed Limits) Order 2015" insofar as it relates to Items a), b) and c) of Schedule 1;
- e) The "Lancashire County Council (Various Roads, West Lancashire Borough) (Part Revocation, Restricted Road 30mph, 30mph and 40mph Speed Limit Order) 2017" insofar as it relates to Items a), d), f), g) h), i), j), k), l), m), n) and o) of Schedule 2;
- f) "The County Council of Lancaster (Restricted Roads) (No.6) Order 1971" insofar as it relates to Item (ii) of the Schedule;
- g) "The Lancashire County Council Moss Lane (Also Known As Straight Up Lane) and Wyke Lane, North Meols, West Lancashire District – Restricted Roads Order, 1997" insofar as it relates to Items 1. and 2. of The Schedule.
- h) Schedule 2 of the "Lancashire County Council (Blaguegate Lane, Skelmersdale and Crosshall Brow, Ormskirk, West Lancashire Borough) (Revocation, Restricted Road and 40mph Speed Limit) Order 2013".
- i) Article 1 of the "Lancashire County Council (Cobbs Brow Lane, Cobbs Clough Road and Whalleys Road, Skelmersdale, West Lancashire Borough) (Restricted Road, 30mph and 40mph Speed Limit) Order 2013".
- j) Schedule 1 of the "Lancashire County Council (Higher Lane, Beacon Lane and Hillock Lane, Dalton, West Lancashire Borough) (Restricted Road and 40mph Speed Limit) Order 2012"
- k) Schedule 2 of the "Lancashire County Council (Various Roads, Bickerstaffe, Down Holland, Halsall, Scarisbrick, Aughton and Hesketh Bank, West Lancashire Borough) (Revocation, Restricted Road, 30, 40, 50 and 60mph Speed Limit) Order 2012".

Where no further speed limit is re-introduced, the speed limit will revert to restricted road status by virtue of street lighting, where a 30mph speed limit will apply.

This Order will come into force on the 31st August 2026.
